The ROOT of All Fears...

Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings. And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden. Then the Lord God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?" So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, an I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself." (Gen 3:7-10)

The ROOT of All Fears...

- Fear entered into the human race immediately after Adam and Eve sinned:
 - wanted to be like God (knowing good and evil)
 - did not trust God's goodness (so they didn't want to depend on or listen to God 100%)
 - forced to face the reality: "I am naked (insufficient, very limited, lacking)", i.e. unable to manage/control our own lives/circumstances"

+ COURAGE

(always give yourself another chance)

Ways to Overcome Fears?

FAITH (trusting God)

- Faith opens doors for God to do wonders in our situations
- Faith enables us to access Heaven's reality (unlimited protection, power, peace, joy and resource, favor,...)
- Faith unlocks all our potential and gifts so we experience much more joy and satisfaction in all aspects of our lives

How to Increase Your Faith?

- Tear down the stronghold of Fear in your belief system
- Honor God, and do things that will enhance your relationship with the Lord (worship, meditate on His Word, talk to Him, obey His commands,...)
- Stick around people of faith (positive, joyful, open, thankful, giving, practical, ...)

Ways to Overcome Fears?

COURAGE (always give yourself another chance)
